9	Will there be any consideration or opportunity for an earlier reconciliation?	Reconciliation will occur either at 3 months after the end of a contract or in the month of March in the state fiscal year following the payment state fiscal year. DFPS does not have plans to vary from this schedule.

For this example assume we had 45 children in care every day during a month with 30 days: 45 (number of children in care for full month with no changes in census) X 30 (Number of days in the month) 1,350 (Placement Days in the month) / 30 (divided by the # of days in the month) 45/7 (1:7 ratio of staff to youth)  6 7 (FTEs – rounded down up to nearest whole #) (means 6 7 shifts per day)  6-7/x 15.46 (\$ / hour) \$ 92.76 108.22 (total \$ / hour)  x 8 (hours per 24 hour period)  \$ 742.08 865.76 (Supplemental daily payment)  x 30 (Days in the month)  \$ 22,262.40 25,972.80 (one month supplemental payment)	The application of the formula is accurate with the exception of the rounding. The formula will round up. In the example you round up 6.42 to 7, not down to 6 shifts. Corrections to your formula are noted in red and strikeout.
11	Emergency shelter ratio is 1.24 awake staff. No treatment services. Is this still correct? I saw ratio to be 1.15 in the slide.	The ratio used in the DFPS supplemental payment methodology is unique to the formula in calculating child FTEs, not to be mistaken with the caregiver to child ratio required by HHSC Licensing standards. The ratio of 1:15 will be applied to GRO Emergency Shelters.

13	So, this payment does not go through the SSCC?	Correct. Community-Based Care SSCC network service providers, who also contract with DFPS and possibly multiple SSCCs, will receive an aggregated payment and subsequent reconciliation processed under a specific DFPS Agency Account ID#.
		In the case of Community-Based Care SSCC network providers who presently do not contract with DFPS and upon the execution of a DFPS agreement, payment and reconciliations will be managed in the same manner as stated above.
