DFPS collaborates with organizations that extend their services to families regardless of child welfare involvement. Community partners work proactively to provide support, resources, and assistance.



A Child Placing Agency (CPA) provides foster homes or placement of children who come into the child welfare system needing a safe place to live. CPA's also recruit and support new foster families and prospective adoptive parents.

The CPA's listed here go above and beyond to also support families and youth at risk of entering into the child welfare system by providing temporary placement and other support services at no cost allowing families to stay together.

Youth Emergency Shelters provide temporary residential care and specialized services to children who have been abandoned, run away, homeless or removed from their homes. Some youth require respite care during family conflicts and emergency shelters can assist families in need. On average, children live in shelters for 30 days, but the stay can be longer, or shorter depending on the program, the child's age, and the circumstances. The emergency shelters listed below provide direct support services to families and youth in need, at no cost.

General Residential Operations (GRO): Can be GRO basic care facilities or GRO treatment for emotional disorders. Both provide services that meet a child's basic need for shelter, nutrition, clothing, nurturing, socialization, and interpersonal skills. GRO's for emotional treatment go a little further in providing care to children and young adults that includes treatment for services for emotional disorders, such as mood disorders, psychotic disorders, or dissociative disorders.

- Assistance in job preparation and attainment: Like gaining employability, building workplace skills, and career counseling.
- Mental health care: Like individual and group counseling and substance abuse education, prevention, and treatment services.
- Basic life-skills building: Like budgeting, using credit, housekeeping, menu planning, and cooking.
- Interpersonal skill building: Like establishing positive relationships with peers and adults, making decisions, and managing stress.
- Educational opportunities: Like graduating from high school or attaining a GED credential, postsecondary training or vocational education.

Crisis Respite Services: Crisis respite provides short-term, community-based crisis care for children, adolescents, and adults who pose a low risk of 6 harm to themselves or others and may have some functional impairment that necessitates direct supervision and care, but who do not require hospitalization. This is the least intensive, facility-based crisis option. Services may be provided for up to 10 days. Many people served in these programs have experienced an event causing significant distress, are having housing challenges, or have loved ones or caretakers seeking temporary support or supervision for the person.
