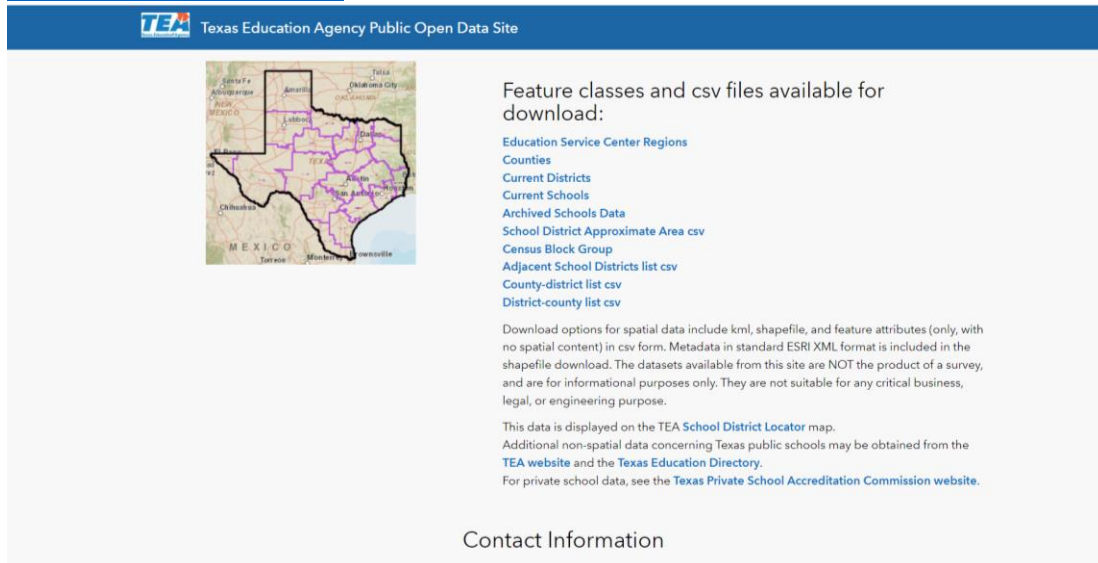


TEA School District Codes
