... require us to:

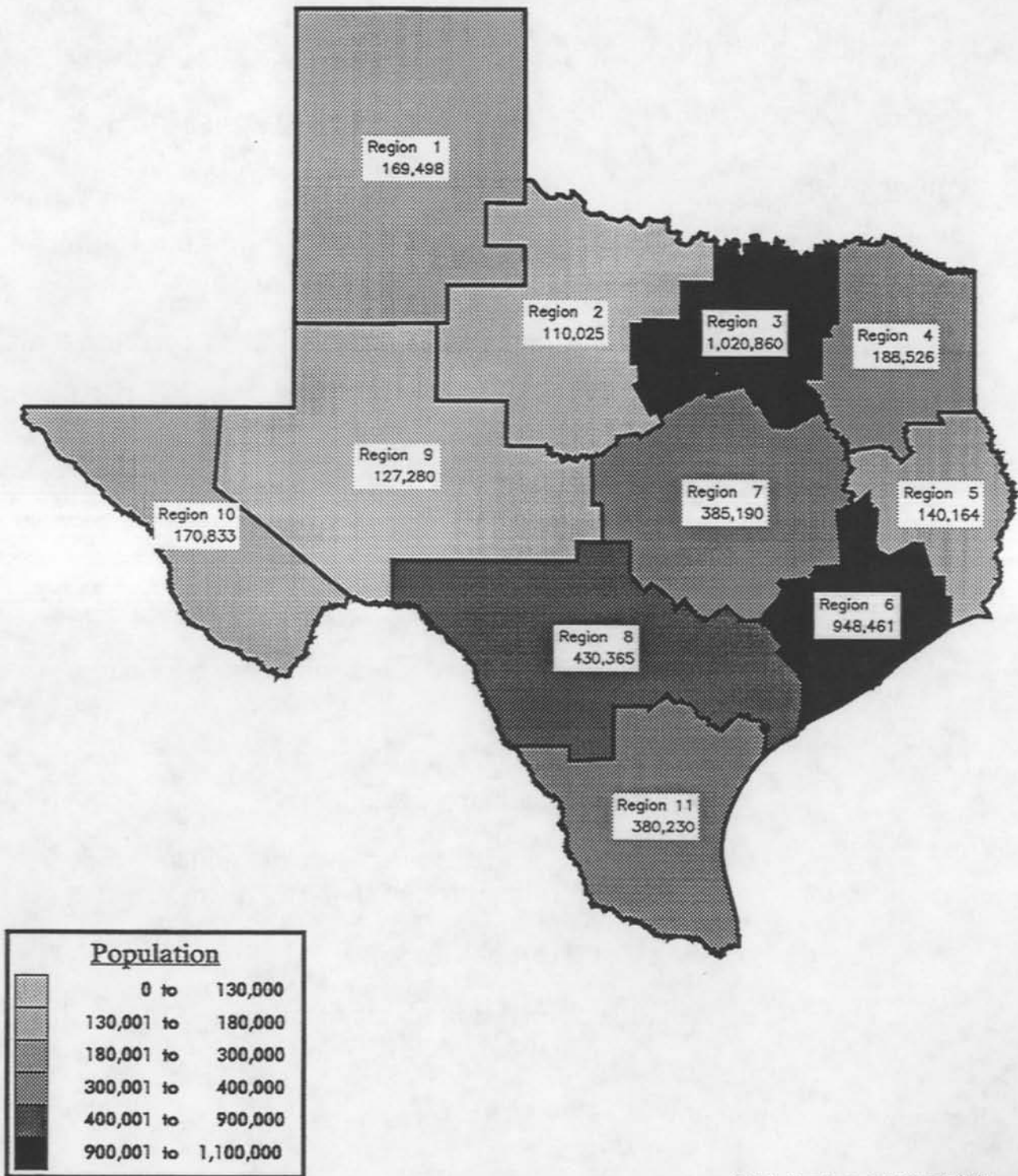
- License child placing agencies;

# Child Population by Region (Ages 0-13)

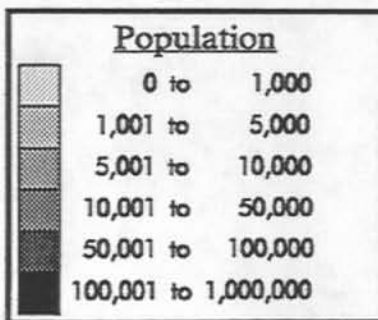
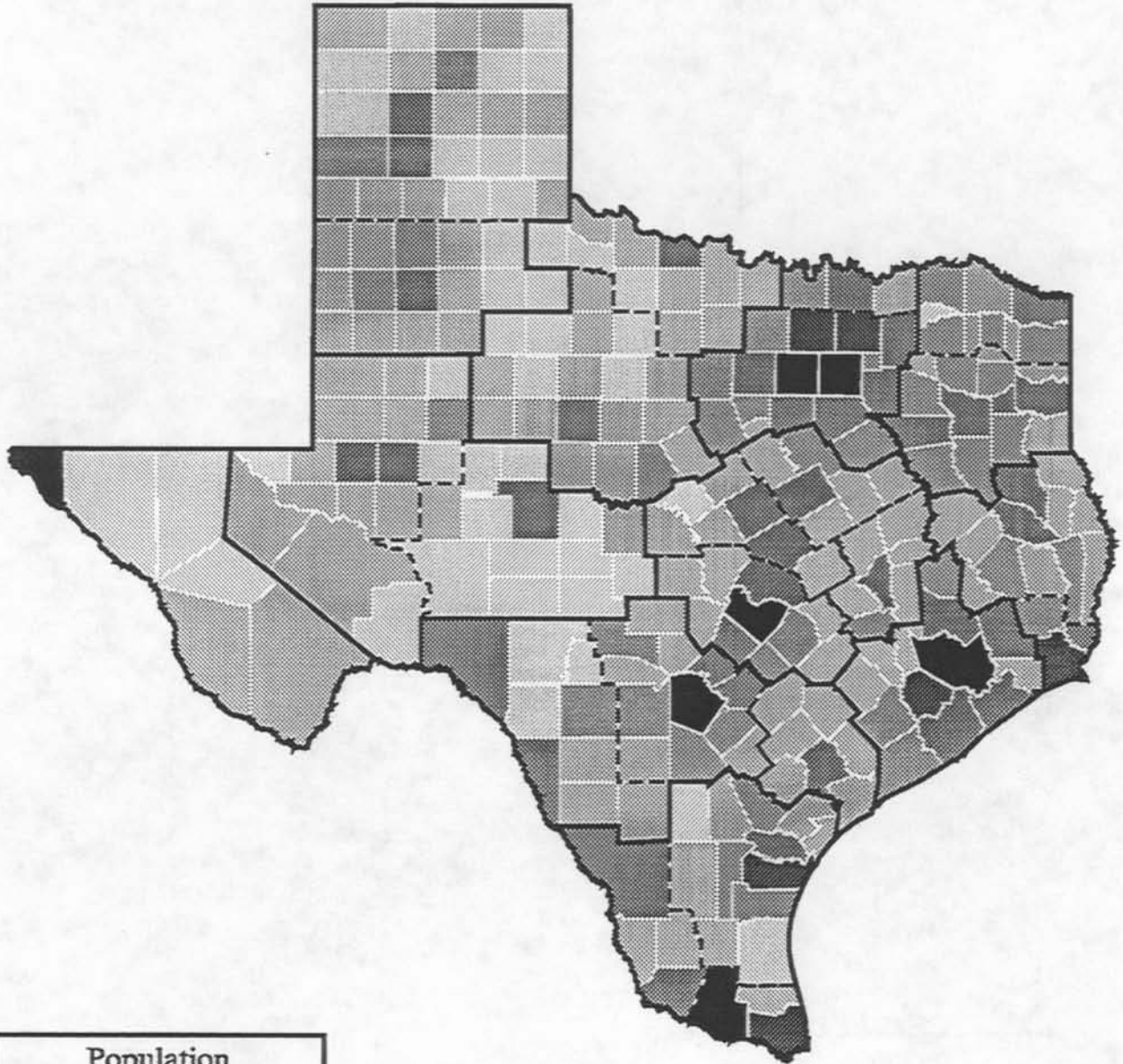

# Child Population by County (Ages 0-13)

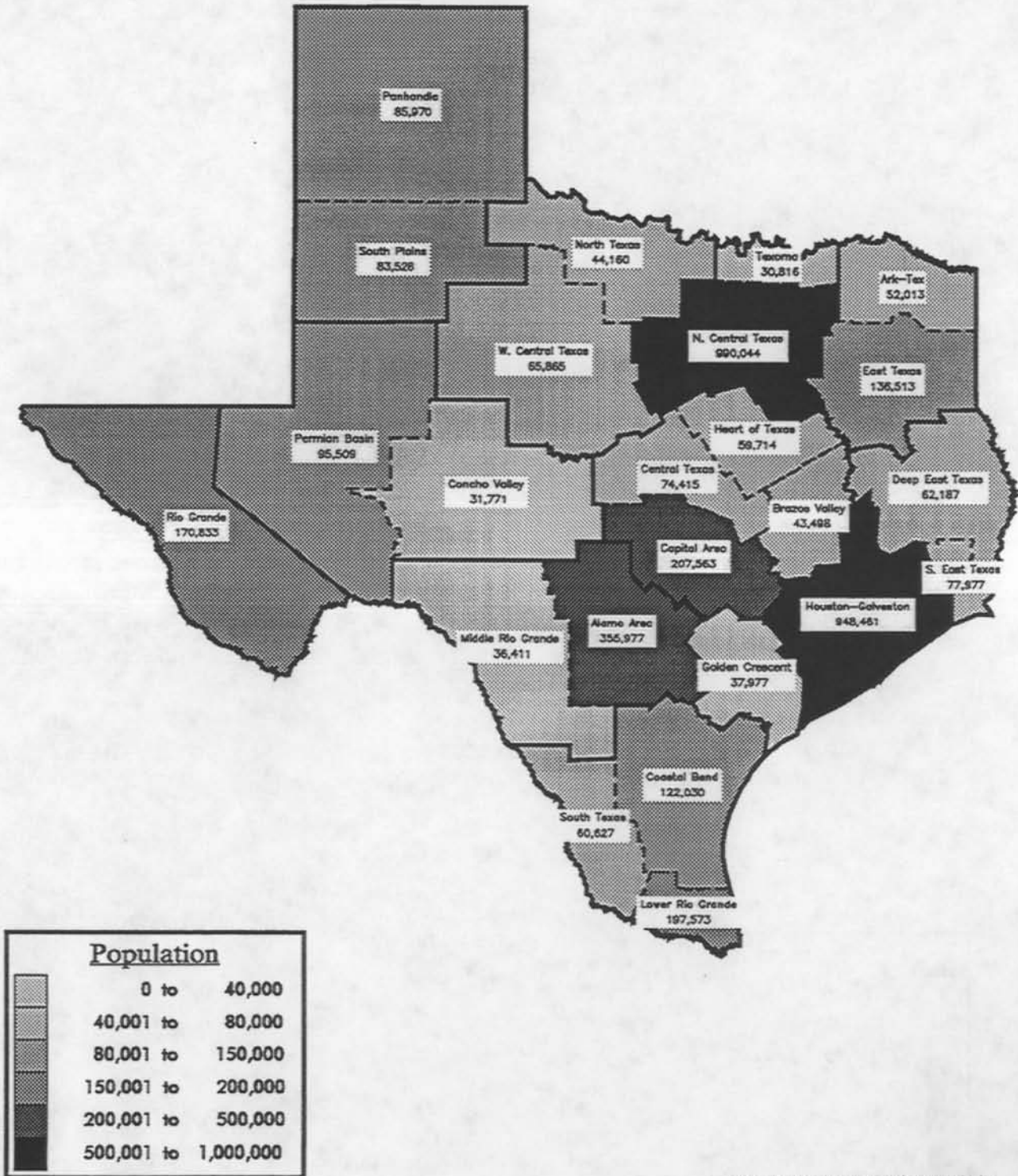

# Child Population by COG (Ages 0-13)

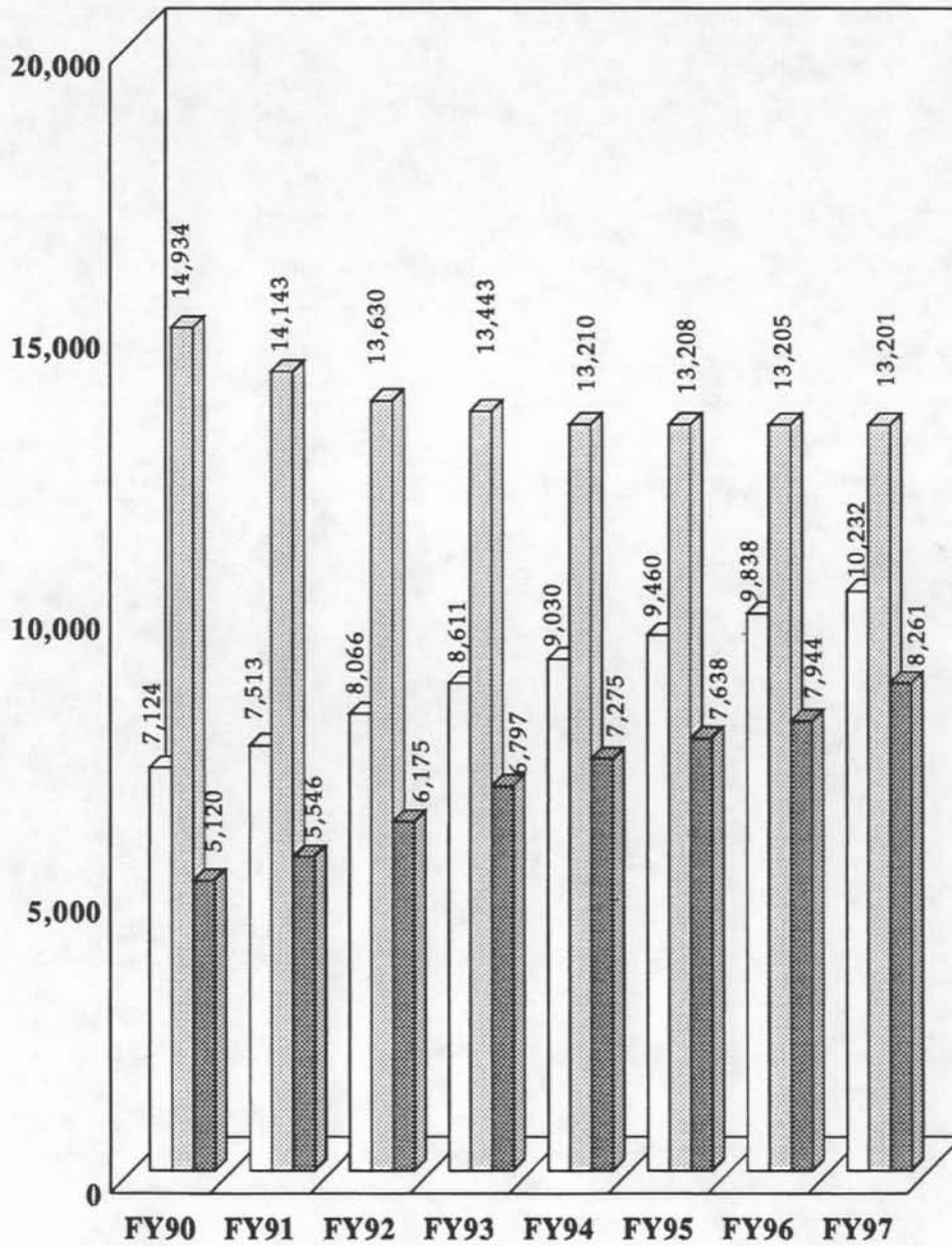

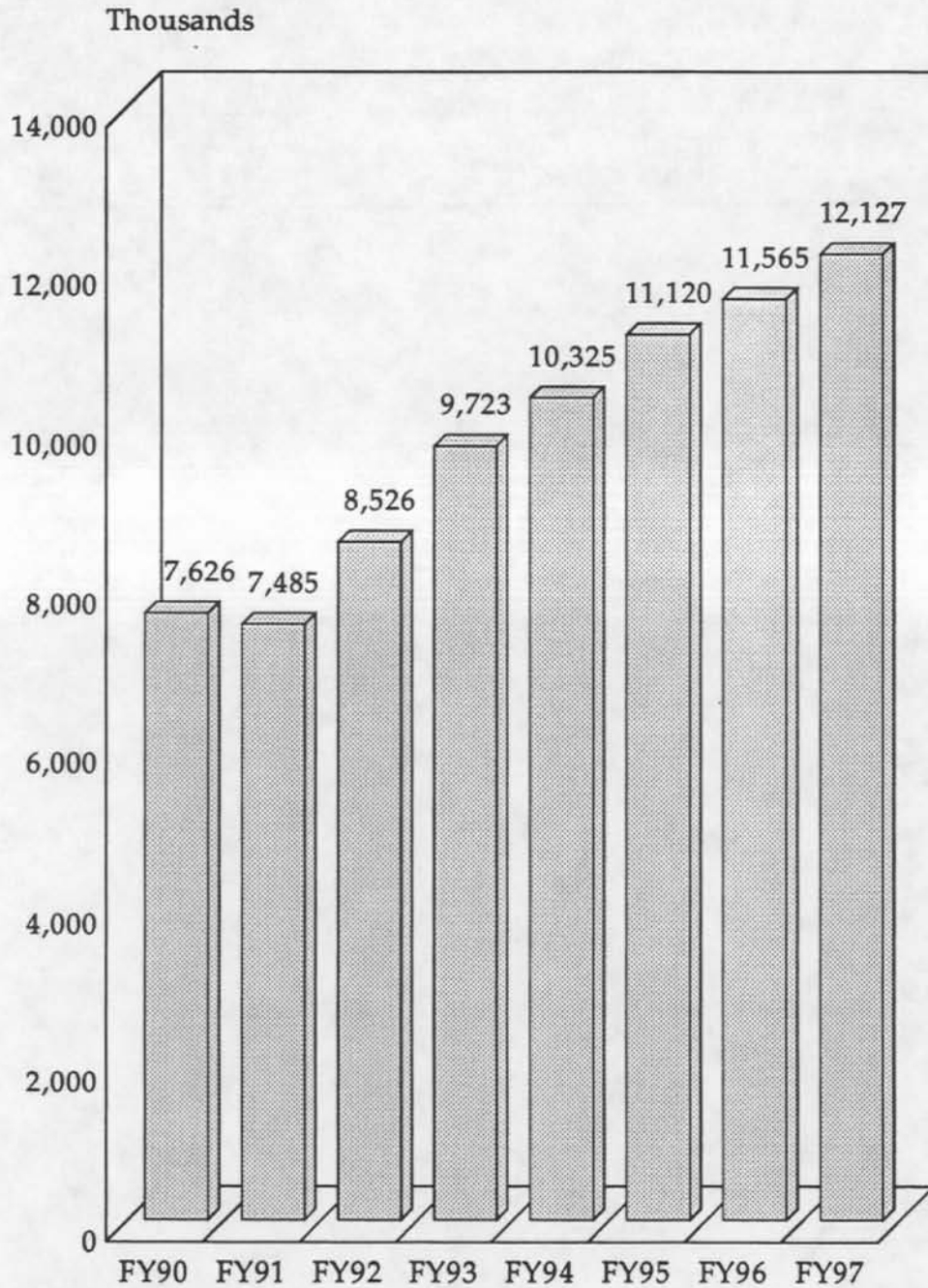

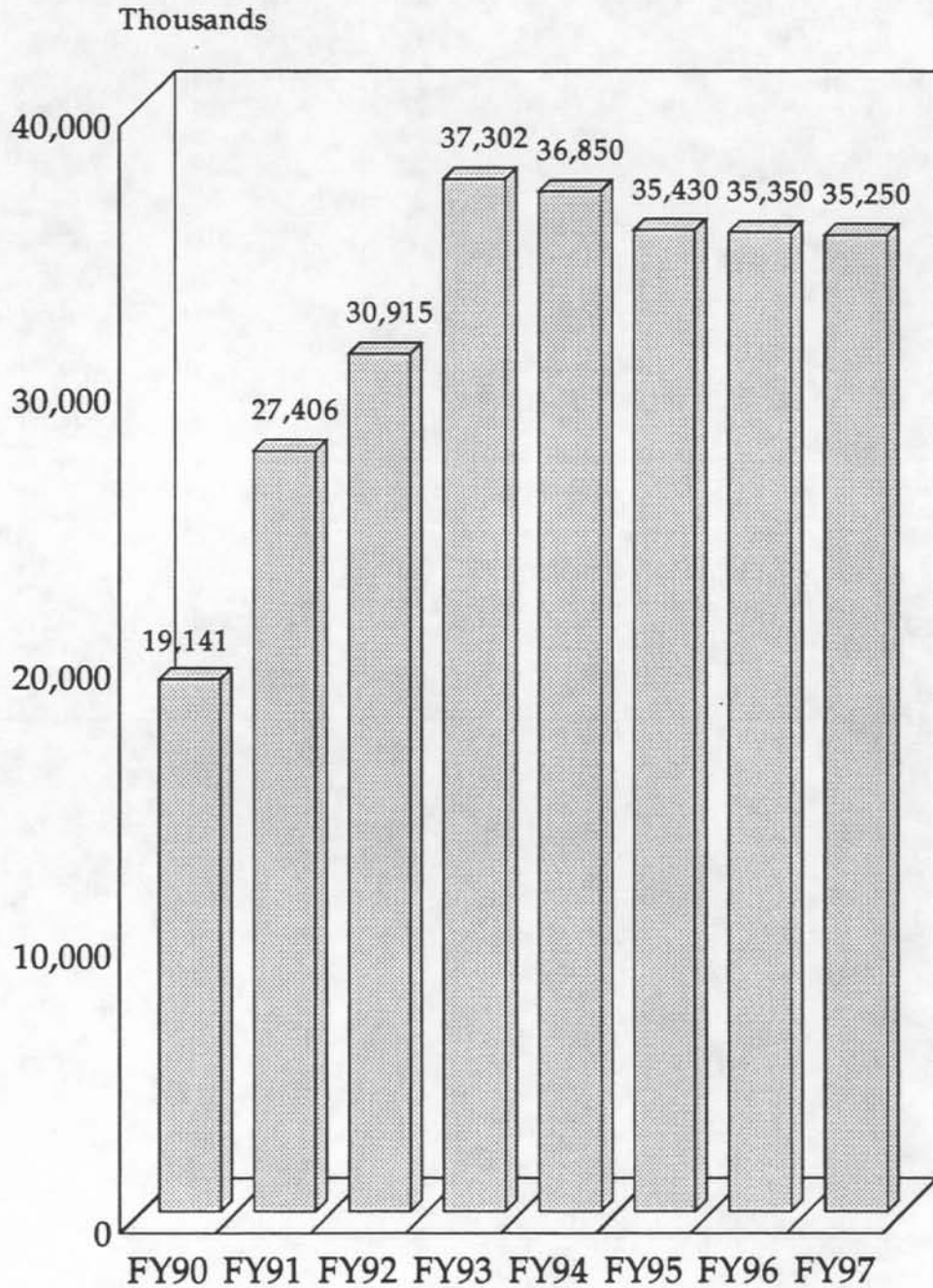
