The Central Texas Foster Care Collaborative is a public/private collaboration to develop and implement a coordinated plan to address the continuum of placement needs to find ample safe and loving families for the children who are in the court system due to child abuse or neglect. This partnership is open to any child placing serving Region 7, that wish to participate in this initiative and are willing to commit support to the initiative as outlined.

Our mission is to assist partner agencies in recruiting, training, and retaining foster families and child-placement staff in an efficient and effective manner. Applicants interested in providing foster care will be encouraged to attend one of our Information Meetings. Then the applicants will be encouraged to choose from among the partner agencies and continue the process of training and licensing through their chosen agency. Each agency has a unique mission in the foster care area, so applicants interested in fostering should carefully consider their agency choice.
