ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO MODIFY

Pending is Defendants' Motion to Modify this Court's order dated March 18, 2020 (D.E. 837). Plaintiffs have confirmed they are not opposed to the relief requested therein. Therefore, after due consideration, it is the opinion of the Court that Defendants' Motion to Modify should be GRANTED.

Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that Defendants shall have until January 1, 2021 to implement heightened monitoring as to all the operations identified in the list provided to the Monitors on June 5, 2020.

It is further ORDERED that Defendants are permitted to compile documentation related to heightened monitoring under the March 18, 2020 Order using a manual process until such time as the enhancements necessary to the CLASS system are in place.

In light of this Order, the Court also amends its Order to Show Cause (D.E. 934) to confirm that Defendants are not required to show cause as to why they should not be held in contempt and sanctioned for failing to comply with Remedial Order No. 20 (D.E. 606).
