An Introduction to IMPACT 2.0

IMPACT, which stands for "Information Management Protecting Adults and Children in Texas," is the primary system of record for case management used by DFPS programs to record case information about the children and adults the agency protects. DFPS uses IMPACT to document all stages of service of a case, including when someone reports abuse, neglect, or exploitation and when those cases are investigated.

An Introduction to IMPACT 2.0 - Modernization



The IMPACT case management system is being upgraded through a multi-year project called IMPACT Modernization and Case Connection for CASA. This started back in 2014. The goal is to bring you a better case management system that is more user friendly and is updated with more tools so that you can continue performing your work effectively.

Note: The modernization effort will make improvements in these areas and also add new features that allow staff to work more effectively and to manage casework more efficiently. This more user friendly system is intended to allow caseworkers to spend more time with children and families.

The Roll-Out

Because IMPACT 2.0 Modernization is a large initiative that introduces many new features and functionality, DFPS decided to roll it out in smaller sections, called "Phases". Each phase may have multiple "Releases".

Phase 1 focused on improving and updating Statewide Intake (SWI), adding and updating multiple applications, such as eReports, Automated Background Check System (ABCS), and CASA.

Phase 2 (known as "IMPACT 2.0") covers all the other program areas, stages, and divisions. It introduces a more modern look and feel along with new functionality. Because of its size, it is rolling out in multiple releases. In December 2017, Release 1.0 introduced IMPACT 2.0 to Investigations (INV); in February 2018, Release 1.1 introduced it to Alternative Response (AR). At this time, three releases are scheduled. However, the number of releases may increase based on the complexity and size of a release.

When it is fully rolled out, it will become the integrated case management system representing all the different divisions of DFPS. Legacy IMPACT will go away and SWI IMPACT and the updated IMPACT 2.0 will be combined to create one complete system.

What is the Interim State?

Because IMPACT 2.0 is rolling out in several releases, not every stage of service has access to IMPACT 2.0 at the same time. Some staff are continuing to function in the existing IMPACT (Legacy), while others are working in the new IMPACT 2.0. Some work in both. We call this period of transition as we move to create a cleaner, more modern, and efficient IMPACT system the "interim state." During this interim state, the IMPACT 2.0 team will keep you informed and provide any information such as guidance, tools, education, that you need to perform your work.

Interim State in Release 2.0

- 1. With Release 2.0, more than 9000 IMPACT users will start performing most of their work in IMPACT 2.0. There will be some functions that staff will continue performing in Legacy IMPACT, creating an extension of the interim state. Details regarding the interim state and how they will affect stakeholders will be available on the IMPACT 2.0 Safety Net (LINK) webpage closer to the release and will also be available to download in word document format for CPS and CCI.
- 2. In general, DFPS staff use Legacy IMPACT until a release moves their work role to IMPACT 2.0.
- In Release 1.0 and 1.1, CPI (INV, and AR) moved to IMPACT 2.0.
- In Release 2.0, users in CPS (including CVS and FBSS), Investigations (CCI), and Provider Investigations will transition to IMPACT 2.0.
- In Release 3.0, remaining DFPS IMPACT users (including APS In-Home Investigations) will move to the new system.
- As a last step, the fully updated Phase 2 IMPACT 2.0 will be integrated with the SWI IMPACT (Phase 1 IMPACT) to produce a single integrated system.



For earlier releases (i.e. Release 1 and 1.1), key messaging related to this interim state compared it to the experience of living in a house undergoing remodeling: some staff work in the updated environment; others, in the old environment; still others, in both environments. For the next release (i.e. Release 2.0), the analogy remains true, but the "house" has been renovated much more broadly. All staff can live in it, but some will perform some of their work in a room or two that is still under construction. The adjacent image depicts this concept.

Look and Feel of IMPACT 2.0 - My Tasks and Assigned Workload

1. Here is the **My Tasks: Assigned Workload** page in IMPACT 2.0. Notice that the page elements such as navigation tabs and assigned workload information in the image are the same as in the related Legacy IMPACT page, but have a more modernized "look and feel".

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Look and Feel of IMPACT 2.0 - Question Mark (?) Icon and Logout

 When the Question Mark (?) icon is selected, a drop down box will appear with options for you to access hyperlinks that are based on your security permissions. The hyperlinks will link you to Help, DFPS Program Handbooks, 2 1 1, and various database searches. You will need to have current security permissions for many of the databases or an

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account to access the databases, if required. When you select the arrow button next to your name, the **Log Out** option will display. Select the **Log Out** button to log out of IMPACT 2.0.

2. As you navigate beyond the **Assigned Workload** page, you notice first tier (primary menu) tabs are still at the top of the page, but instead of the submenus being placed directly underneath the top tier tabs as in Legacy IMPACT, the second tier (secondary menu) appears in a column on the left hand side. When there is a third tier (tertiary menu) of menu options, it will appear in a row to the right of the second tier.

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Release 2.0 Key Changes for Child Protective Services

- 1. Here is an overview of the key changes for Child Protective Services (CPS):
- Assessment Tools : You will be able to complete the Assessment Tools for:
 - Safety Assessment in FRE, FSU, and FPR stages
 - Family Strengths and Needs Assessment (FSNA) in FRE, FSU, and FPR stages
 - **Risk Reassessment** in **FRE** and **FPR** stages
 - Reunification Assessment in FSU Stage
- Child Plan of Service (CPOS): IMPACT 2.0 now automatically creates an Initial Child Plan along with a SUB stage when a child is removed from the home and a placement has been entered. Expandable/collapsible sections, prefilled fields, and conditional displays are features of the Child Plan that streamlines your entry of the required plan details.
- **Family Plan of Service:** You will be able to complete Family Plans in the following stages:
 - FPR
 - FRE
 - FSU
- Medical Consenter Form: This form has been redesigned for a new look and feel with the added functionality of capturing wet signatures onscreen. Additionally, Medical Consenter forms are now accessible via hyperlinks on a new list page.
- Application for Placement Form (Common Application): The new Application for Placement (Common Application) is introduced and has a new layout. You will be able to access the Application for Placement from the Common Application page in SUB stage.

- **Child Sexual Aggression:** The new **Child Sexual Aggression** page will enable select users to record episodes of sexual aggression by a child.
- **Runaway/Missing:** You will be able to report and track children in DFPS care who run away or go missing.
- FBSS Monthly Evaluation: On the Contact Detail page in the FPR stage, a new Caregiver(s) and Child(ren) section now displays when you select the new "Monthly Evaluation" option from the Type dropdown. The new section will have the same structure as the Principals/Collateral Contacted section that is currently displayed when you select "Contact" from the Type dropdown.
- **CPOS Access:** External users will have access to the **RCCP Workload** page where they can view, edit, and update certain **Child Plan** information.
- External User/External Organization Management: You are now able to view and edit the details about a Residential Child Care Provider (RCCP) external user, and view, add, and edit the details about an external organization in the IMPACT database.
- Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children (ICPC): Revisions have been made to the approval process workflow for 100A-Placement Requests and 100B-Placement Statuses to ensure that the approvals for these now flow through all three levels of approval where the DFPS Supervisor provides the first-level approval, the Regional Office ICPC Coordinator provides the second-level approval, and the State Office ICPC Specialist provides the third-level approval.
- **Title IV-E:** IMPACT 2.0 enables CVS workers, Removal field staff, CPI staff, and FC Eligibility Specialists to complete a **Foster Care Eligibility Application** for a youth in the SUB stage to determine eligibility for Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) in the month and year that the removal petition is filed (a requirement for Title IV-E assistance).
- **PAL/NYTD**: Improvements have been made to the functionality and quality of reporting for Preparation for Adult Living (PAL) and the National Youth in Transition Database (NYTD) .
