Strategy Description and Justification: (1,600 Character Limit)
Under Executive Order RP 35, HHSC was directed to review and reform the CPS program. Detailed recommendations were developed and SB 6 was enacted by the 79th Legislature that outlined a comprehensive reform of DFPS to improve its services. An unprecedented increase in funding and FTEs was provided to achieve the improvements. CPS Reform funding contained in this sub-strategy provided additional resources for more staff to perform searches in the automated system and merge individual and case records which allows CPS case history on individuals to be found quicker and more efficiently.
