Under Executive Order RP 35, HHSC was directed to review and reform the CPS program. Detailed recommendations were developed and SB 6 was enacted by the 79th Legislature that outlined a comprehensive reform of DFPS to improve its services. An unprecedented increase in funding and FTEs was provided to achieve the improvements. CPS Reform funding contained in this sub-strategy provided resources for DFPS to contract for more substance abuse services that are primarily delivered to families who either have a child in foster care or a receiving family based safety services due to the high-risk of having a child removed. This sub-strategy crosswalks to Strategy 1.2.8 Substance Abuse Purchased Services.
